**Our Mission:** To ensure the safety of Scouts and Scouters involved in Unit, District and Scout Camp climbing, rappelling and associated activities by training Climbing Instructors and certifying that they are current with the required technical skills, safety knowledge and current BSA Policies.

## Who Should Go:



Adult's (18+) interested in teaching the basics of climbing and rappelling or managing a climbing or rappelling program for Scouts that has:

- **A high level of prerequisite knowledge in belaying, knots, equipment and hardware** (Required in order to receive a "BSA Lead Climbing Instructor" certificate in this course)

- Completed the "Climb On Safely" course at [www.myscouting.org](http://www.myscouting.org). Once you have completed the course, print out a copy of the completion certificate and bring it with you to the course.

**Cost:** \$85 Includes the cost of the course as well as meals, beginning with a cracker barrel on Friday night up to and including lunch on Sunday.

**Expected Outcomes:** Upon successful completion of this course, you may receive either a certificate as a "BSA Lead Climbing Instructor", "BSA Climbing Instructor" or "BSA Climbing Instructor-In-Training". This certificate will be good for 2 1/2 years expiring on December 31<sup>st</sup>. You are then able to act as a "Qualified Instructor", per your certificate, for a Unit, District or Council Climbing/Rappelling activity.
