Unit Commissioner Online Fast Start Now Live

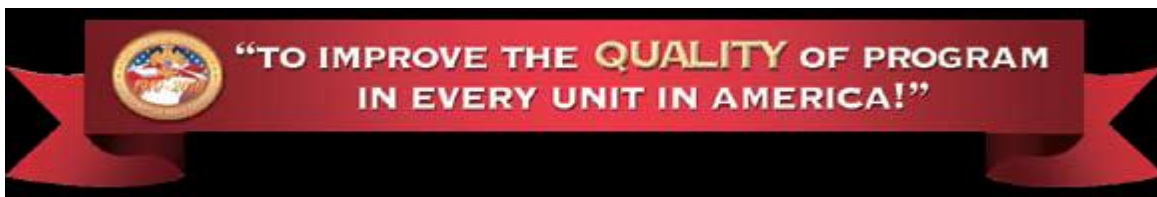
As part of your initial training as a commissioner, you need to take the Unit Commissioner Fast Start. You can access the training by using your existing MyScouting account to go to the Online Learning Center or creating a new account. Go to www.scouting.org, then log in to the Online Learning Center. If you do not have Internet access, get with your commissioner coach and take the fast start course with him/her at your earliest convenience. This course will give you some basic information on what the job of a unit commissioner is and how to carry out your responsibilities to better serve the units you have been assigned.

Change in Position on Uniform of Commissioner Arrowhead Honor

Based on the new uniform design, it has been approved for the commissioner Arrowhead Honor emblem to be worn on the left sleeve of the commissioner's uniform immediately below the council strip. This replaces the previous location of below the badge of office for commissioners.
